

Position Purpose:

Perform all radiology technology duties in an exemplary fashion. Possess a positive attitude while following all Allegro Pediatrics policies and procedures. Maintain a positive working relationship with staff, managers, directors, and physicians.

Reporting Relationship:

This position reports to the Clinic Manager and/or Back Office Lead.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Must perform all radiological duties as allowed by licensure which can include medical records processing of film/scans, CDs, etc.
- Must train designated medical assistants and nurses to perform radiology technologist duties as requested by the administration at Allegro Pediatrics.
- Autoclave instruments for the clinic as needed.
- During down time process immunization records requests left on voice mail.
- Provide patient mobility assistance as necessary.
- Provide general health education within own level of expertise and as directed by practitioner and nurse supervisor. Assist in collecting and distributing patient education materials.
- Must uphold the terms of the Allegro Pediatrics Confidentiality Agreement.
- Must attend 80% of all monthly staff meetings.
- Must complete mandatory trainings successfully.
- Must work in any/all Allegro Pediatrics clinics as needed.
- Must work on weekends and holidays as scheduled.
- Must work a minimum of 36 hours per week on average.

- Current Washington State DOH Radiologic Technologist Certification
- Graduate of a certified Radiology Technology program.
- CPR certification preferred.
